Net Payroll -	Net payroll is equal to gross payroll less tax withholdings and other deductions. Payroll is paid twice per month on the 15th and 30th (or last day of the month, whichever comes sooner).
Other payroll	Other payroll expenses relate to employee withholdings, social security, insurance, and other deductions.
PRIFAS	Puerto Rico Integrated Financial Accounting System.
RHUM System -	This is the software system that DTPR uses for payroll.
TSA	TSA means Treasury Single Account, the Commonwealth's main operational bank account (concentration account) in which a majority of receipts from Governmental funds are deposited and from which most expenses are disbursed. TSA receipts include tax collections, charges for services, intergovernmental collections, the proceeds of short and long-term debt issuances and amounts held in custody by the Secretary of the Treasury for the benefit of the Commonwealth's fiduciary funds. Only a portion of the revenues received by the TSA is included in the annual General Fund budget presented to the Puerto Rico Legislative Assembly for approval. Other revenues are separately

assigned by law to certain agencies or public corporations but still flow through the TSA.

Introduction

- Enclosed are the following Monthly Reports: (1) Actual Cash Vendor Disbursements by Agency vs Liquidity Plan; and (2) Total Payroll Related Disbursements by Agency vs Liquidity Plan.
- TSA is the Commonwealth's main operational bank account (concentration account) into which a majority of receipts from Governmental funds are deposited and from which most expenses are disbursed.
- Disbursements from the TSA include payroll and related costs and vendor and operational disbursements (including those reimbursed by Federal assistance grants and funded from Special Revenue Funds), which are the subject of the data contained within this document. Additional disbursements from the TSA not contained within this report include welfare expenditures, capital outlays, debt service payments, required budgetary formulas and appropriation payments, pass-through payments of pledged revenues to certain public corporations, tax refunds, payments of current pension benefits and other disbursements.
- Gross Payroll cash disbursements are equal to the sum of: (i) Net Payroll (actual cash disbursements to individual employees), (ii) Other Payroll (withholdings, benefits and other deductions) and (iii) Wage garnishments by Agency. The relevant data are extracted from the DTPR RHUM system.

Key Takeaways for the month ended June 30, 2020:

The enclosed report includes consolidated TSA monthly cash outlays for vendor payments and gross payroll for central government agencies compared to the Liquidity Plan. Though gross payroll variance has remained relatively flat throughout the year, this is mostly due to consistent positive payroll variance in the DOE that is offset by various monthly negative variances in Salud, Department of Public Safety, and others. Positive variance in DOE payroll is driven by consistently lower than forecasted federal fund outlays. Beginning in April, additional variances have resulted from payments that are part of the FOMB-approved COVID-19 Emergency Measures Support Package. These include \$46.6M for Police, \$16.0M for the Department of Correction and Rehabilitation, \$3.0M for the Department of Health, and \$10.4M for other agencies. YTD variance in vendor disbursements is mostly driven by lower than expected payments on behalf of the Department of Education and the Department of Health. Total disbursements variance is primarily attributable to positive Federal Fund variance, accounting for 76.4% of the \$1.5B variance. General Fund and Other State Fund disbursements contributed 24.6% and -1.0% of the variance, respectively. Disbursements under custody of Treasury ballooned in June due to \$130M of payments related to the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) Strategic Disbursment Plan. As of July 3, 2020, the CRF has reimbursed the TSA for these payments.
