The Puerto Rico Health Insurance Administration (PRHIA) will continuing using the same HEDIS metrics that have been reported for the past years except for the Frequency of Ongoing Prenatal Care (FPC) which has been retired. Be advice that the measurement period for the HEDIS 2020 is January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019. Also, for the next year, the HEDIS metric list will remain the same.
