1	Can ASES clarify if this NNSP is intended for award to one consulting services provider or is the agency seeking multiple forms that would operate under a Master Services Agreement?	As per item 6 in the NNSP, proposals must indicate hourly rates. ASES reserves the right to discuss and negotiate multiple forms of operating on a master services agreement with awarded proponents. ASES also reserves the right to choose one or more contractors to serve as a consultant in the areas of expertise mentioned in the NNSP. The number of contractors that could be awarded a contract will depend on ASES' needs. The contract to be awarded is the traditional professional services contract.
2	The NNSP does not include specific projects but instead project areas in the list of potential services; Does ASES want the potential contractor to propose projects and hours or only provide experience and qualifications?	Experience, qualifications, and hourly rates for services of the nature being sought in the NNSP.
3	Will ASES provide questions and responses from all possible respondents?	As stated in the NNSP, answers will be provided by email and posted in the web page along with the NNSP.
