MCOs, MAOs and PBM

The Puerto Rico Health Insurance Administration (PRHIA or ASES, for its Spanish acronym) needs an advisor with vast experience in federal managed care regulations (42 CFR Part 438) in the areas of Medicaid, Medicare, federal compliance, public accounting and finance and implementation support for special projects. Pursuant to Law No. 72-1993, as amended, PRHIA invites interested companies to submit competitive proposals.

The consulting services to be provided under this process will include, but not be limited to, the areas of grant management, government accounting and finance support, regulatory and contractual compliance and audits for the Government Health Plan (GHP or "PSG" for its Spanish acronym) and other ASES – "Vital" Programs, Medicare Advantage (Platino) and Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) & Rebate Aggregator (RA). Some of the special projects included in the scope of work of the RFP include but are not limited to: a) Operational Risk Screening and Assessment of ASES operations; b) MLR risk assessment and audits of Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) and Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs); c) PRMMIS-related operational support, including analysis to determine impact of premium payments (PMPM) to MCOs and MAOs with PRMMIS data; d) specialized technical assistance and counseling in the monitoring of the MCOs to ensure full compliance with applicable APR-DRG program regulations; e) evaluation of options to improve ASES's current financial accounting tools to achieve efficiency and alignment with PRMMIS; and f) support ASES in the design and implementation of new processes and protocols to address new changes required by changes in PRMMIS.

The contractor shall be independent of any MCO under the Vital Plan (MCO) or health care provider in the GHP, any MAO, ASES's PBM (Abarca Health, LLC), and be free from direct or indirect financial conflicts of interest with any GHP MCO/MAO/PBM and/or health care provider.

At the time of granting the RFP, the Offeror must be authorized to do business in Puerto Rico, have a current certification from the Puerto Rico General Services Administration (ASG) Single Registry of Professional Services Providers (RUP), be enrolled in the System for Award Management (SAM), and not be disqualified, suspended, proposed for disqualification, or declared ineligible for contract award by any federal and state department or agency.
