This RFI, along with a potential future RFP, is an integral part of these ongoing efforts.

At this moment, PRHIA is not planning to include direct contact with pharmacies in the Scope of Work. This may be considered in a future RFP if PRHIA determines it is necessary.

10	Appendix B - Contract No. 2023-000048	1-133	or defining the allowable number of	Section 7.6.1.16 of the Contract states that the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) and its subagencies and PRHIA shall have the right to inspect, evaluate, and audit any pertinent books, financial records, documents, papers, records of any Network Pharmacy involving financial transactions related to the Government Health Plan (GHP).

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			Also, Sections 35.2.3-35.2.4 establish that PRHIA, CMS, the Office of Inspector General, the Comptroller General, the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit, and their respective designees shall have the right at any time to inspect. evaluate, and audit any pertinent records or documents of the Contractor and Subcontractor, and may inspect the premises, physical facilities, equipment, computers or other electronic systems where activities or work related to the GHP program is conducted. This right to audit exists for ten (10) years from the final date of the Contract Period or from the date of completion of any audit, whichever is later. Also, it is established that PRHIA "shall have unlimited rights to use, disclose, and duplicate all Information and Data in any way relating to this Contract in accordance with applicable Puerto Rico and federal laws and regulations".  Considering these clauses, any further specification of audit rights, including a maximum number of sample claims allowed for review, would have to be established in a separate agreement or contract amendment.
