FIRST ADDENDUM TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The PRBP issues this First Addendum to the RFP (“First Addendum”), according to the terms and conditions set forth thereunder, including, but not limited to, RFP’s Section XII, in order to address and publish the responses to the inquiries received as December 4, 2023, subject to the Reservation of Rights levied in RFP’s Section XIII.

Id.	Inquiry	Response
1	Would an entity transitioning from ‘Individual’ to a ‘Corporation’ qualify under the description stated on Page 3 of the RFP (i.e., “intended for ‘shovel ready’ project that can be implemented expeditiously”)?	Through the RFP, the PRBP is seeking responses from Applicants that meet the requirements set forth under its Section V. That section in turn states that Applicants must meet certain requirements, including: “[h]ave a minimum of three (3) years of incorporated status, along with the corresponding ‘Good Standing Certificate”, <i>Id.</i> In light of the foregoing, an entity transitioning from ‘Individual’ to a ‘Corporation’ could qualify if said three (3) year threshold is met, along with the other requirements set forth in the RFP.
2	How should the ‘Response Template’ TAB be completed?	The “response template tab” includes some cells with controlled or predetermine values, on those cells the proponent should select one of these values. Where pre-determined values are not set, answers must be typed.
