



ORDER 2021-016

TO AMEND ORDER 2021-015, FOR THE SOLE PURPOSES OF GRANTING AN EXTENSION FOR THE FIRST DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF STATUTE NO. 7 – 2019

Statute No. 7 - 2019, known as the “Prescription Drug Price Transparency Act” (Act No. 7), delegated to the Department of Consumer Affairs (DACO) certain obligations under its ministerial duty. In compliance with the legislative mandate, Order 2021-015 was promulgated on July 16, 2021. After the promulgation of said Order, some pharmacies requested a new one, claiming that they needed additional time to configure their systems and be able to comply with the provisions of Statute No. 7.

In consideration of the aforementioned, and under the powers delegated to DACO by its Organic Law, as well as those provided in Law No. 7, the Secretary issues the following:

ORDER

Section 1: Term Extension for Disclosure of Information

The date of the first disclosure of information under the provisions of Act No. 7, as set forth in Order 2021-015, will be between September 1 and 5, 2021. The rest of the provisions of the aforementioned Order remain unaltered.

Section 2: Reconsideration

Any person who considers to be adversely affected by this Order, may request its reconsideration under the provisions of the Statute No. 38 - 2017, known as the “Uniform Administrative Procedure Law of the Government of Puerto Rico”.

Section 3: Validity

This Order will enter into force at the time of its signature, and its provisions remain in effect until expressly provided otherwise.
