REGULATION TO ESTABLISH THE STANDARDS MEASURES OF DISCIPLINARY CONDUCT

The Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW), in accordance with Section 2.1 of Law No. 38 of July 30, 2017, as amended, known as the "Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico", publish this Notice for the enactment of the afore mentioned Regulation.

The purpose of this proposed Regulation is to establish an impartial, effective, objective and uniform method to establish the standard measures of disciplinary conduct at the workplace. This is promulgated in accordance with the faculties granted to the Secretary of the Department of Transportation and Public Works by the Reorganization Plan Number 6 of 1971, enacted by Law 113 of June 1968, as amended, known as "Reorganization Law of 1968" and Article 407 of the Political Code of Puerto Rico, 3 LPRA, Section 412.

The proposed Regulation will be available during working days and hours at DTPW Minillas Governmental Center, South Tower, 17 Floor, Ave. De Diego Santurce, Puerto Rico. All printed copy of the Regulation will be available upon payment of the corresponding fees in each agency. It will also be available, free of charge, at DTPW's website: www.dtop.pr.gov.
