2050 Long Range Multimodal Transportation Plan Draft documents for revision and comments

The Department of Transportation and Public Works and the Puerto Rico Highway and Transportation Authority through Strategic Planning Office and the Puerto Rico Metropolitan Planning Organization herein notify to the public, municipalities, organizations, and state agencies, the availability of draft documents for the 2050 Long-Range Multimodal Transportation Plan.

Federal Law number 117-58, titled: "Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act" (IIJA) of November 15, 2021 (better known as Bipartisan Infrastructure Deal), stipulates and requires jurisdictions to develop a long-term transportation plan. In fulfilling its duty, this requirements also represents an opportunity to develop a transportation plan through a continuous, cooperative and comprehensive effort on a horizon of at least 20 years. After a process of citizen consultation through informative workshops and surveys, the plan documents are submitted for review and comments.

The Draft Documents of the Multimodal long-term 2050 include:

- 2050 Long-Range Multimodal Transportation Plan for Puerto Rico
- 2050 Long-Range Multimodal Transportation Plan for the San Juan Metropolitan Area
- 2050 Long-Range Multimodal Transportation Plan for the Aguadilla Metropolitan Area
- 2050 Long-Range Multimodal Transportation Plan for Urbanized Areas
(population of less than 200,000 inhabitants)
