



SECOND PUBLIC NOTICE

REGULATION FOR THE USE OF THE DIGITAL PLATFORMS TO PERFORM TRANSACTIONS OR PROCEDURES RELATED TO MOTOR VEHICLES BY COMMERCIAL ENTITIES

The Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW), in accordance with Section 2.1 of Law No. 38 of July 30, 2017, as amended, known as the "Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico", publish this Notice for the enactment of the afore mentioned Regulation.

The purpose of this proposed Regulation is to adapt the dispositions of Act 55-2024, establishing as a requisite to commercial entities the use of existing digital platforms in the DTPW, to perform the registration of new vehicles, transfers and consultations of vehicles and persons, refinancing transactions, imposition and release of liens attached to motor vehicles, payment of fines and all other transactions related to motor vehicles in the DTPW. This Regulation will apply to all commercial entities that execute these types of transactions or procedures including, but without limitation to: Dealerships, Guaranteed Creditors (including Financial Institutions, Title Loan companies and Credit Unions), insurance companies, license acquisition representatives, daily leasing entities (both short and long term), Vehicle fleet entities or vehicle leasing companies, Official Inspections Stations and any other entity which would be added or mentioned in the future.

The proposed Regulation will be available during working days and hours at DTPW Minillas Governmental Center, South Tower, 17 Floor, Ave. De Diego Santurce, Puerto Rico. All printed copies of the Regulation will be available upon payment of the corresponding fees in each agency. It will also be available, free of charge, at DTPW's website: www.dtop.pr.gov.

A public hearing will be held on July 17, 2024, at 10:00am at Roberto Sanchez Vilella Government Center (Minillas), Ground Floor, South Tower, De Diego Avenue Santurce, Puerto Rico.
