



## Invitation to New Members Continuum of Care (CoC) PR-502

The US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) promotes the Continuum of Care (CoC) Program under 24 CFR 578, which brings together various sectors to work in a coordinated manner on housing planning and services for the homeless persons or at-risk of homelessness. The CoC PR-502 covers a geographical area of twenty-four (24) municipalities in Puerto Rico: Aibonito, Arecibo, Barceloneta, Barranquitas, Bayamón, Camuy, Carolina, Cataño, Ciales, Comerio, Corozal, Dorado, Florida, Guaynabo, Lares, Morovis, Naranjito, Orocovis, San Juan, Toa Alta, Toa Baja, Vega Alta, Vega Baja, and Utuado. The Department of the Family is the collaborative applicant of CoC PR-502.

In compliance with 24 CFR 578.7 (a) (2), the Governance, Regulation and Membership Committee invites those sectors interested in being part of the CoC to send a letter of intent to Ms. Liz Mónica Lamboy López, executive director CoC PR-502 via email at [llamboy@familia.pr.gov](mailto:llamboy@familia.pr.gov) with copy to [coc@familia.pr.gov](mailto:coc@familia.pr.gov).

The relevant sectors include government agencies and municipalities, nonprofit organizations and other providers of housing services, social services, health services, and other services aimed at the homeless population, affordable housing developers, law enforcement agencies, and individuals with lived experience of homelessness, among others.

To be a member with voice and vote in CoC meetings, the following conditions must be met:

- a. Have an official letter of appointment from the agency you represent. If you are an individual, you must submit a letter of intent to become a member.
- b. Have participated in sixty percent (60%) of the plenary meetings during the previous calendar year.
- c. Participate in at least one PR-502 CoC Committee, of which you must participate in at least fifty percent (50%) of the meetings.
- d. Have received the recommendation of the Membership Committee.
