

NOTICE

The general public is hereby notified that **HERITAGE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY**, an insurance company organized under the laws of Arizona and authorized to do business in Puerto Rico as a foreign insurer, has filed with the Office of the Insurance Commissioner of Puerto Rico an application for authorization to acquire control of **TRANS - OCEANIC LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY**, an insurance company organized under the laws of the Government of Puerto Rico.

Any person who has a legitimate interest in participating in the administrative hearing may, in advance of the date of such hearing, mail to the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance, PO Box 195415, San Juan, Puerto Rico 00919, a duly substantiated written request to be allowed to intervene or participate in such proceeding. The Commissioner shall determine that the interests of such person may be affected, shall permit the intervention and the latter shall have the right to be assisted by counsel, to present evidence, to cross-examine and cross-examine witnesses, and to present oral and written arguments, in accordance with Articles 2.190, 2.200, 2.210 and 2.220 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico.

At such a public hearing, the person who filed the statement Heritage Life Insurance Company, Trans - Oceanic Life Insurance Company, the persons who were notified of the hearing, and any other person whose interests may be affected shall have the right to present evidence, to cross-examine and cross-examine witnesses, and to present oral and written pleadings in accordance with sections 2.190, 2.200, 2.210 and 2.220 of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico.

Pursuant to Section 44.030(d)(2) of the Insurance Code of Puerto Rico, the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance shall hold a public hearing to consider such request:
