RE: Request for Approval of the Distribution of Municipal Funds for the *Ama de Llaves* Program – Fiscal Year 2026

The Fiscal Year 2026 Commonwealth Budget Resolution (the “FY2026 Budget”) allocates \$15 million to support municipalities to provide social well-being services through the *Ama de Llaves* program, subject to the Financial Oversight and Management Board’s (FOMB) review and approval of a distribution plan.

Pursuant to the Fiscal Year 2026 Budget, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) respectfully submits for the FOMB review and approval the proposed distribution of \$15 million allocated for the *Ama de Llaves* Program. This initiative supports municipalities in providing essential social services to the citizens of Puerto Rico.

For Fiscal Year 2026, the OMB utilized the same distribution formula established by the FOMB for Fiscal Year 2025, duly updated with the most recent demographic, income, and fiscal capacity information available for each municipality. This distribution has been discussed and developed jointly with the FOMB’s team that handles municipal matters. The purpose of working on this collaboratively is to ensure consistency, transparency, and adherence to the criteria previously validated by the FOMB. We understand that we can improve the FOMB’s methodology for establishing these distributions; however, the current need is to release the funds as soon as possible. We will be working to present another methodology to be used in the future. The OMB remains firmly committed to facilitating the prompt and effective distribution of these funds to guarantee the continuity of essential social services provided by the municipalities, particularly those that benefit the most vulnerable sectors of our population.

Accordingly, we respectfully request the FOMB’s approval of the proposed fund distribution, as detailed in the attached Exhibit A. All participating municipalities will be required to meet the eligibility criteria set forth in the fund agreement to be executed with the OMB.

The OMB remains firmly committed to ensuring that any distribution of General Fund resources to support critical municipal services is carried out fairly, transparently, and in a fiscally responsible manner.

We trust FOMB will evaluate this request with the urgency it requires, and we remain available to provide any additional information or documentation necessary to facilitate the approval of these funds.
