Re: Response to Disaster Recover Municipalities reapportionment request

Dear Mr. Rivera Berríos,

This letter is in response to a budgetary reprogramming request submitted on behalf of certain municipalities through the Office of Management and Budget (“OMB”) to the Financial Oversight and Management Board for Puerto Rico (the “Oversight Board”) for review and approval.

After reviewing the request and the supporting documents, the Oversight Board makes the following determination:

1. 2026-Disaster Recovery Municipalities Assignments under the custody of the Office of Management and Budget (017) - Interagency transfer from Assignments under the custody of the OMB to multiple municipalities to cover damages from the April-May 2025 flooding event, including repairs to infrastructure, roads, utilities, and essential public services.

Determination: Partially Approved

Approved amount: \$28,693,548

Observation: The Oversight Board partially approves with observations the interagency transfer from the FY2024 Emergency Reserve under the custody of the OMB (account 111-0170000-1248-098-2024) in the amount of \$28,693,548 to the municipalities listed in Exhibit A to cover damages from the April-May 2025 flooding event, including repairs to

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infrastructure, roads, utilities, and essential public services. The Oversight Board denies the interagency transfer in the amount of \$1,802,663 related to funds advanced from the FY2025 Emergency Reserve to municipalities that have not submitted utilization reports of the \$100,000 advances approved in May 2025. Additional funding to municipalities can be reconsidered upon the submission of the aforementioned utilization reports. The OMB should ensure that the disbursement of the Government's Emergency Funds to the municipalities is carried out under revised and strengthened procedures, with appropriate monitoring, budget controls, and oversight of the use of the funds, consistent with the procedures established in OMB Special Memorandum No. 007-2024, including documentation requirements and the return of unspent funds.

OMB shall allocate the approved amounts as detailed in **Exhibit A** in the appropriate PRIFAS accounts.

We trust the foregoing answers the request identified herein and look forward to continuing our work together for the benefit of the people of Puerto Rico.
