Brief introduction of the Executive Order

Executive Order 13576 **pursues the efficiency, effectiveness, and accountability of the Federal Government** and, by extension, the Federal Government funds by reducing expenses and unnecessary waste of funds. The order seeks to reduce financial drain, streamline government operations and elimination of duplicity and useless programs or tasks. Furthermore, the order lays out the end vision of President Obama in 2011, which was the public welfare.



WHO is the Executive Order applicable to?

While the original target of this Executive Order was **agencies and entities of the Federal Executive Branch**, its results are seen through the implementation of Federal programs, over their guidelines and regulations. This is, the Public Policy of reduction, prudence and restraint in the use of public funds, both local and Federal, remain to this day.

Local Entities receiving Federal funds shall adhere to both the Federal and local regulations and restrictions. As today, the Federal government guidelines, such as the Uniform Guidance and even the program specific program guides require to implement and keep:

Performance metrics and progress tracking and review

Restriction on the use of funds

The seeks of transparency & accountability

Even on the last **Uniform Guidance** updates, to be enforced on October 1, 2024, the Federal government is requiring entities receiving Federal funds to demonstrate their capabilities on cybersecurity and protection of data and information.



HOW is the Executive Order implemented?

FEDERAL LEVEL

It was implemented through specific instructions to Chief Executive Officers such as: OMB Director, Vice President, and the Government Accountability and Transparency Board (GATB) establishment.

LOCAL LEVEL

It has been reflected through the regulations and guidelines of Federal programs.

WHEN is the Executive Order applicable?

The effects of this and other public funds austerity ordinances may be reflected as:

Government requirements to monitor and ensure the correct, efficient and effective use of funds.

Conditions of specific performance metrics when using Federal funds.

Responsibility to have in place Policies and Procedures on the effective use of funds on such topics as:

Subrecipients Monitoring



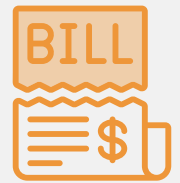
