In accordance with Act 125 of May 7, 1942, as amended, and Regulation 8981 of PRPA Bids and Request for Proposals, the Puerto Rico Ports Authority (PRPA) is requesting competitive bids from contractors, for the project referenced above.

The project consists of the pavement rehabilitation of Runway 9-27 at the Fernando Luis Ribas Dominicci Airport (SIG), San Juan Puerto Rico. The Runway pavement rehabilitation includes the mill and overlay of the Asphalt Concrete (AC) pavement and the pavement rehabilitation of several taxiway connectors to match existing elevations. The scope of work also includes airfield lighting, signage, stormwater drainage pipes and structures, and pavement markings. These scope items are in accordance with contract documents and Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) technical specifications.

Bidders of this project shall submit the Proposal, in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders contained in the Contract Documents, on or before **May 9, 2024, at 10:00 AM**.

A non-compulsory pre-bid meeting will be held on **April 2, 2024, at 10:00 AM** (Local PR Time - AST). This pre-bid meeting will be held at the Conference Room, PRPA Engineering Building (2nd Floor), at Isla Grande, San Juan. PRPA strongly encourages prospective bidders to attend the pre-bid conference.

In order to participate, bidders should request bidding documents and drawings, by filling and submitting copy of the bidder's registration form, included as part of this advertisement, to the following email, JATorres@prpa.pr.gov until **April 5, 2024, 4:00pm**. Bidding documents and drawings will be available for request and distribution after **March 14, 2024, at 12:00 Noon**. Bidders are advised that they must be registered as possessors of the contract documents for the project and possessors of all such amendments.

The Bid Opening will take place on **May 9, 2024, at 10:30AM** at the Conference Room of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority, Central Office, at Isla Grande, San Juan, PR. All bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud by the Bids Board at the same day of the Bid Opening.

The project is conditioned upon the receipt of federal funding under provisions of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), Airport Improvement Program (AIP). Certain mandatory federal requirements apply to this solicitation and will be made part of any contract awarded.
