Project Description:

This project involves the removal, clearing, and re-establishment of existing vegetation along the airport perimeter. The goal is to enhance flight operations, security, and address vulnerabilities in the area. Following recommendations from the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), this initiative aims to strengthen perimeter security and ensure operational areas at the airport are safe and functional for both tourists and residents. Additionally, repairs to the airport perimeter fences will be conducted to secure restricted areas.
