



Regulation for the charging of fees for the issuance of identification cards at federalized certified regional airports, certified regional airports, ports, and piers of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority

The Puerto Rico Ports Authority ("PRPA"), in compliance with Section 2.1 of Act No. 38-2017, known as the "Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico," publishes this notice to provide the public with the opportunity to submit written comments, by email, or to request in writing an oral hearing regarding the proposed action, including the grounds that, in the applicant's judgment, make such oral hearing necessary. Act No. 125-1942, as amended, known as the "Puerto Rico Ports Authority Act," in accordance with Article 4(d), establishes the duties and powers among which is the authority to "Adopt and approve regulations governing its internal operations, as well as those necessary to exercise the powers and authorities conferred upon it by this law." Therefore, through Resolution No. 2025-027 issued on December 18, 2025, the Board of Directors of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority approved the adoption of the following regulation:

"Regulation for the charging of fees for the issuance of identification cards at federalized certified regional airports, certified regional airports, ports, and piers of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority"

This regulation is adopted for the purpose of continuing to promote the objectives of the Authority, which are to develop, improve, own, operate, and manage all types of transportation facilities, as well as air and maritime services under the Authority's jurisdiction. The Authority is responsible for establishing standards to maintain greater control over the handling, use, and charging of fees for the issuance of identification cards to be used at federalized certified regional airports, certified regional airports, ports, and piers under the Authority's jurisdiction. It also repeals Regulation Number 8880, regarding the Charging of Fees for the Issuance of Identification Cards at Airports, Ports, and Piers of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority.

The provisions of this Regulation apply to all persons performing work at facilities under the Authority's jurisdiction.
