



## **Regulations for the Organization and Operation of the Police Department of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority.**

The Puerto Rico Ports Authority ("PRPA"), in compliance with Section 2.1 of Act No. 38-2017, known as the "Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico," publishes this notice to provide the opportunity for the citizenry to submit comments in writing, by e-mail, or request in writing an oral hearing on the proposed action with the grounds that in the opinion of the applicant make it necessary to grant such oral hearing. Act No. 125-1942, as amended, known as the "Puerto Rico Ports Authority Act," pursuant to Section 4(d), establishes the duties and powers among which are "To adopt and approve regulations governing its internal operations, as well as those that may be necessary to carry out the powers and authorities conferred upon it by this Act;". In view of the foregoing, by Resolution No. 2025-008 issued on May 22, 2025, the Board of Directors of the Ports Authority approved the adoption of the following regulations:

### **"Regulations for the Organization and Operation of the Police Department of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority"**

The purpose of these regulations is to determine the functional organization of the Police Department of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority, in order to protect and promote the security of the APPR Jurisdiction. Likewise, to establish processes for the imposition of penalties and processes for review appeals.
